

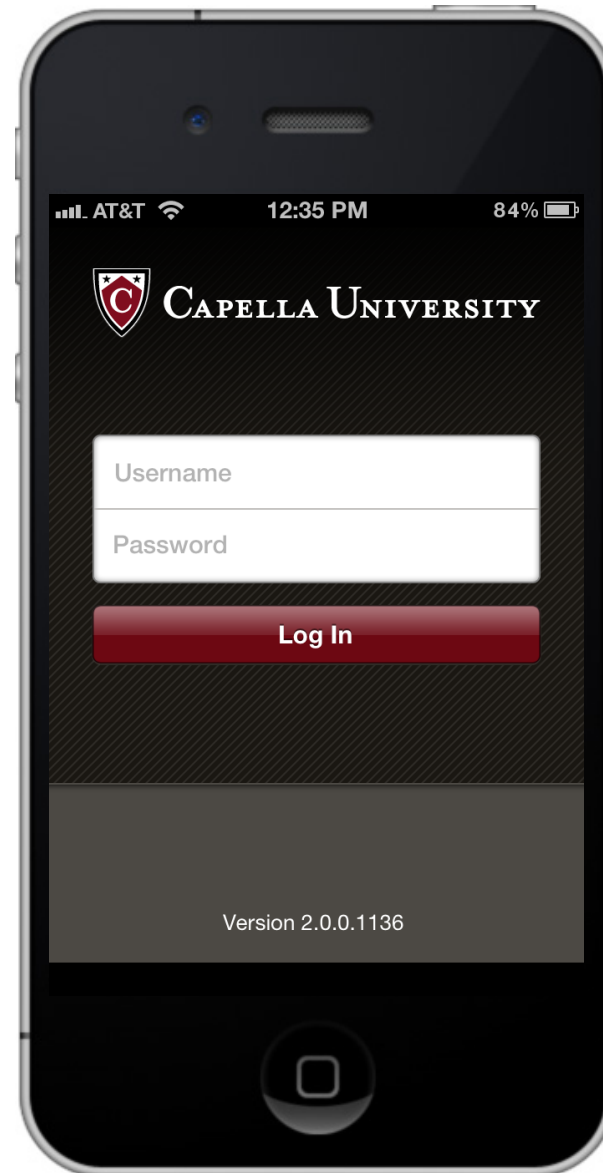

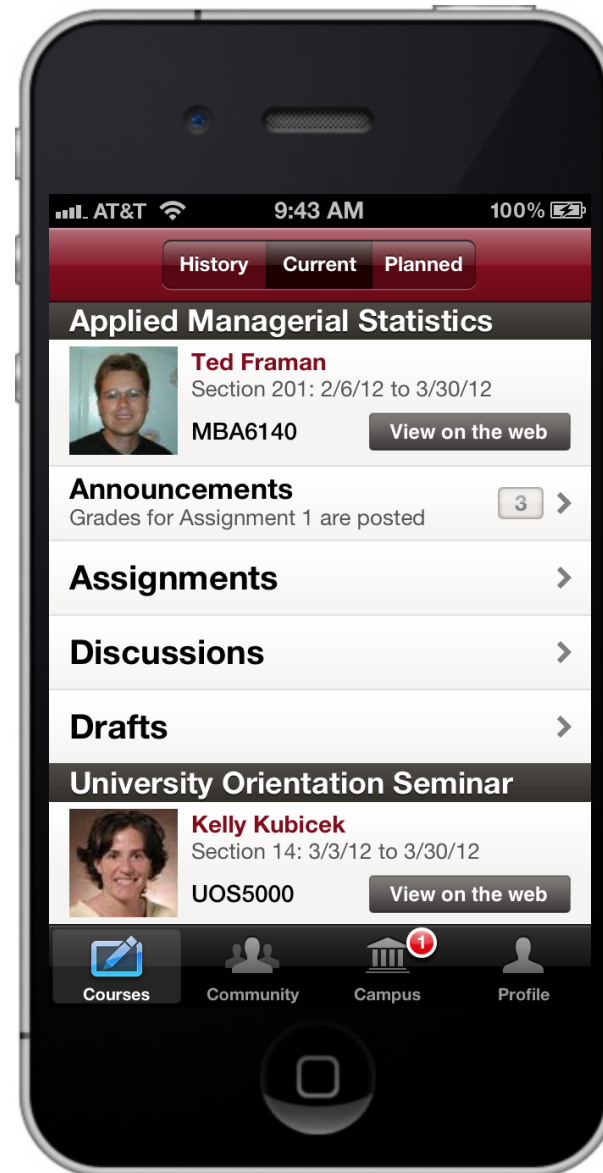

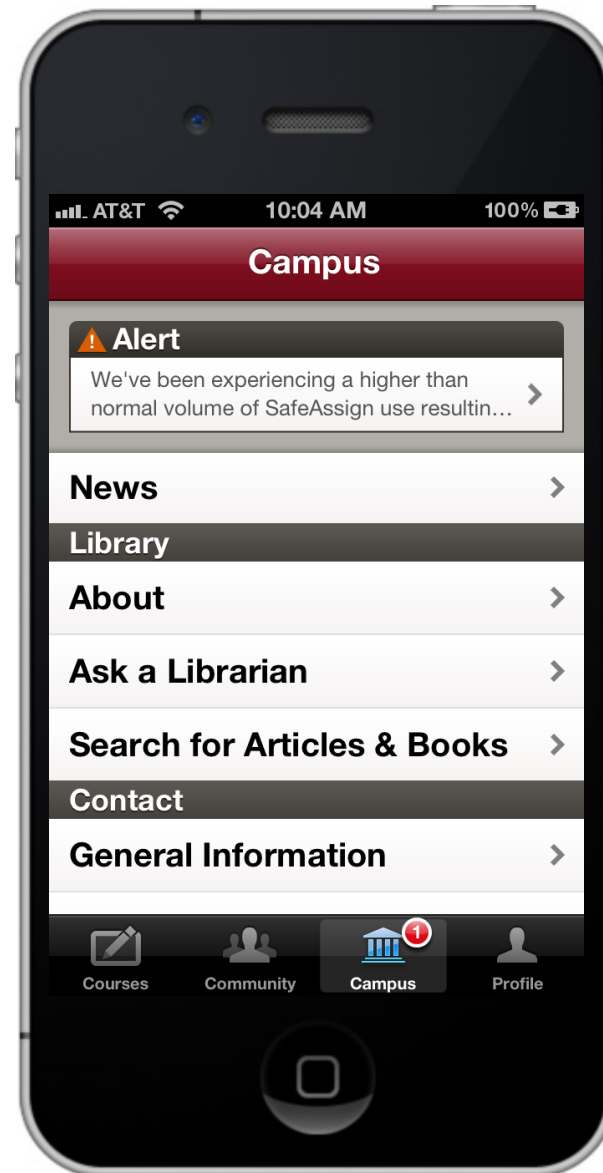

After launching Capella Mobile, learners are required to log in.



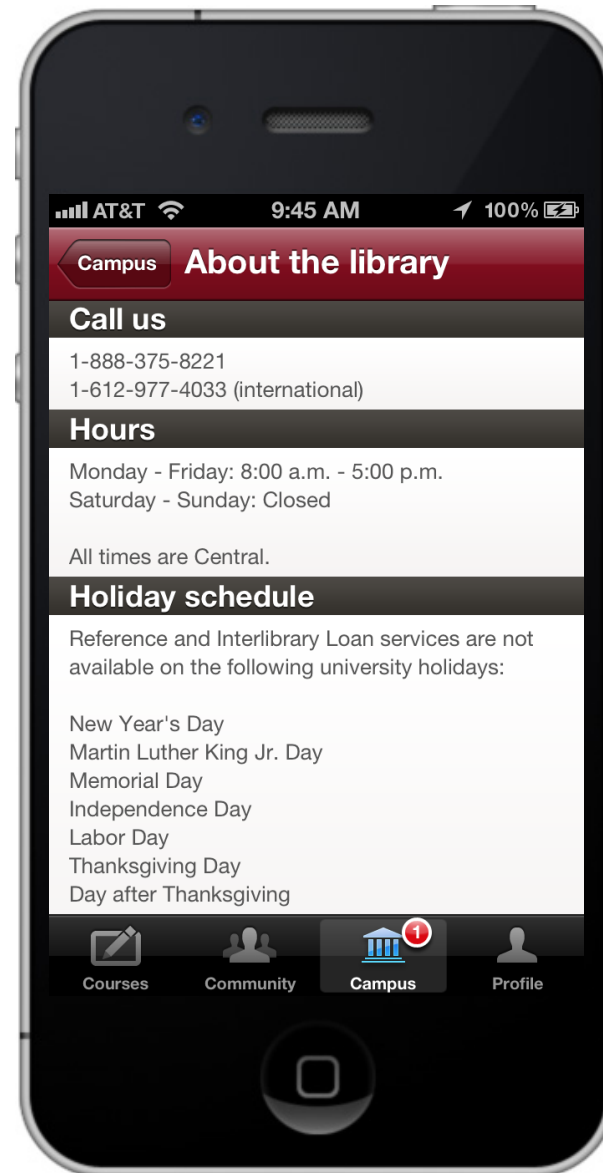
Learners arrive on the **Courses** tab
(in current courses) after logging in.



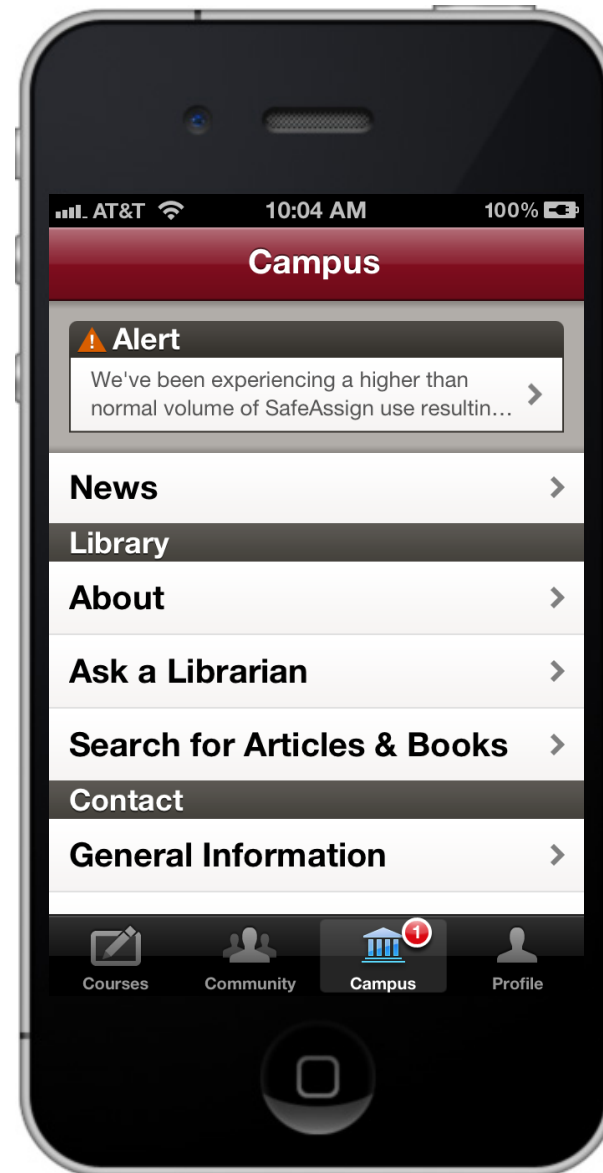


Library is one of the categories in the updated **Campus** tab.

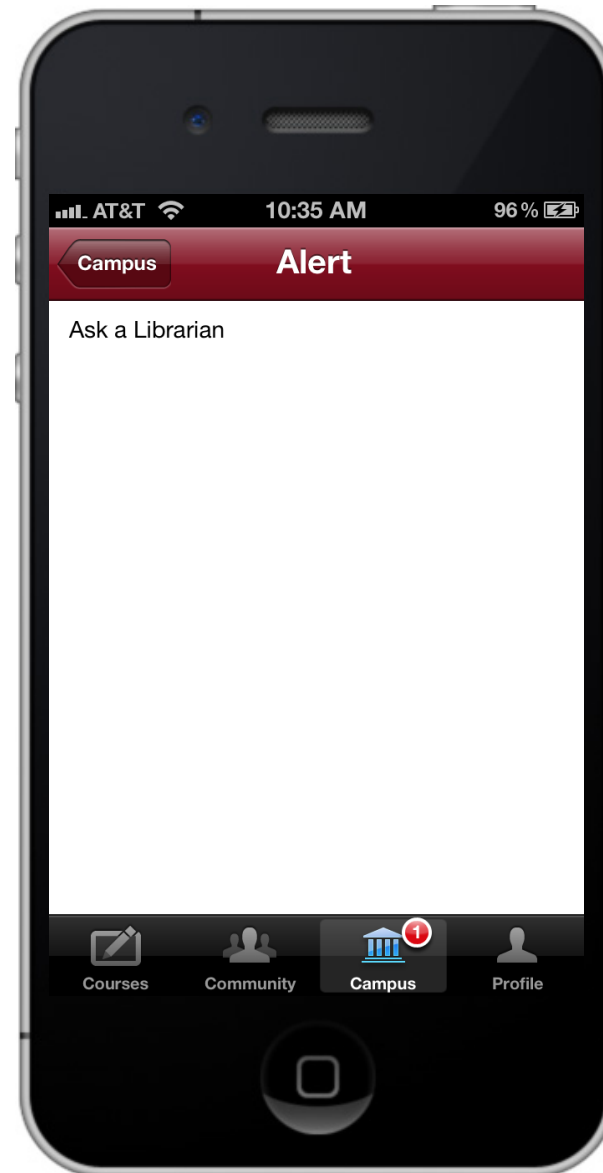
Area 1 of 3 in library:
About the library



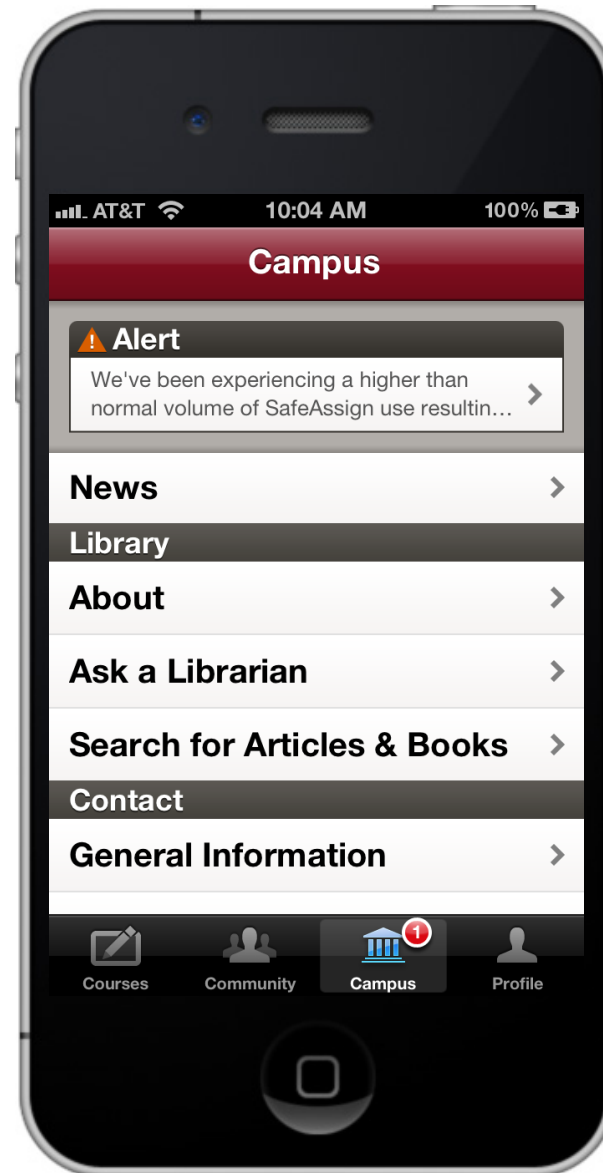
On About the library, tapping on **Campus** returns users to the Campus tab.



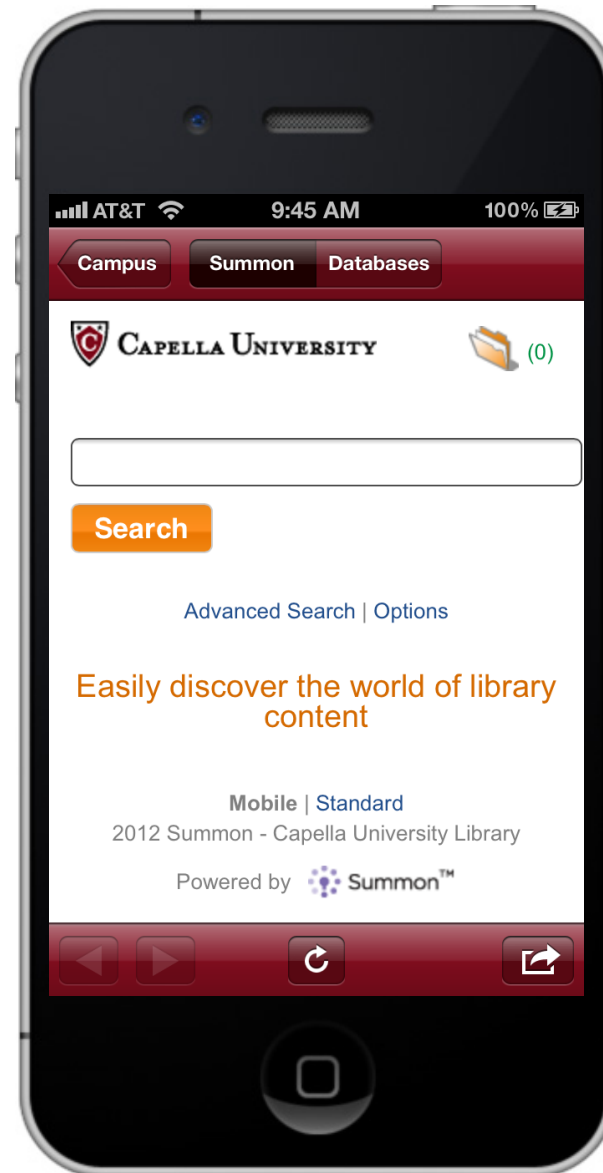
Area 2 of 3 in Library:
